Target group	 PhD holders and Postdocs ✓ working at a higher education institution/university in a non European Developing Country. ✓ not older than 50 years at the time of the Application (eg. born on or after March 1st, 1963). ✓ who were in receipt of a grant of the Republic of Austria (either financed by the Federal Ministry of Science and Research or the Austrian Development Cooperation) administered by the OeAD-GmbH (formerly ÖAD). ✓ finished their last scholarship-supported stay in Austria at least 5 years ago. ✓ not having studied/pursued research and/or academic work in Austria in the last six months before taking up the grant.

Duration	1 to 3 months
Grant benefit paid	 Monthly grant rate: 1,040 EUR Accident and health insurance, accommodation: a) If necessary, the OeAD-GmbH will take out an accident and health insurance on behalf of the grant recipient. b) The OeAD-GmbH will endeavour to provide accommodation. Monthly costs: 220 to 470 EUR (depending on how much comfort the scholarship holder wants). An administration fee of 18 EUR per month is payable to the OeAD-GmbH for arranging the accommodation. Travel costs subsidy of 730 EUR maximum.
